HHW

Acceptable HHW items for Home Pick-up

CHEMICALS (Cumulative 5-gallon limit)

- ▶ Cleaning chemicals (bathroom, carpet floor, tile, toilet, window, etc.)
- ▶ Photochemicals (small batches only)
- ▶ Pool chemicals
- ▶ Aerosols

PAINTS (Cumulative 10-gallon limit)

- ▶ Household, acrylic, enamel, oil or latex paint
- ▶ Paint thinner/stripper
- ▶ Stains

AUTOMOTIVE (Cumulative 5-gallon limit)

- ▶ Automotive fluids (antifreeze, power steering fluid, motor oil, window washing fluid)
- ▶ Car wash & wax
- ▶ Gasoline/diesel/kerosene fuel
- ▶ Tire cleaner/treatment

GARDEN (Cumulative 5-gallon limit)

- ▶ Fertilizers
- ▶ Pesticides

MISCELLANEOUS

- ▶ Circuit boards
- ▶ Fluorescent and CFL lightbulbs
- ▶ Mercury thermostats
- ▶ Road flares only (no shooting flares)

CYLINDERS

- ▶ Camp stove propane tank
- ▶ Fire extinguisher
- ▶ Grill propane tank

BATTERIES

- ▶ Single-use (alkaline)
- ▶ Rechargeable (lithium-ion)
- ▶ Lead acid (car battery)

ELECTRONICS

- ▶ All types of phones
- ▶ Cables & connectors
- ▶ Calculators
- ▶ Cameras & camcorders
- ▶ Computers/hard drives

- ▶ Holiday lights
- ▶ Ink/toner cartridges
- ▶ Keyboard and mice
- ▶ Modems/routers
- ▶ Monitors with unbroken glass (1 per pilot)
- ▶ Portable music players
- ▶ Printers/scanners/fax machines
- ▶ Projectors
- ▶ Remotes and cords
- ▶ Speakers
- ▶ Surge protectors & powerstrips
- ▶ Tablets & e-readers
- ▶ TVs with unbroken glass (1 per pilot, less than 50")
- ▶ Typewriter
- ▶ VCR, DVD and Blu-ray players
- ▶ Video game equipment
- ▶ Webcams

These items **DO NOT** belong in your recycle or trash container.

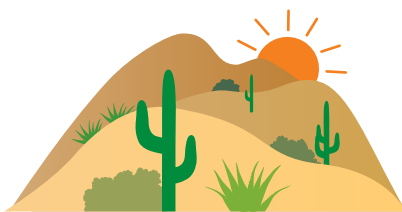
HHW Tips

Do NOT Place HHW Curbside

All items should be placed in a box labeled "HHW" and set next to your garage or front door on collection day



All HHW should be in leakproof and sealed containers to prevent spills during collection

Unacceptable Items

-  **Ammunition or explosives**
-  **Biomedical waste**
-  **Volatile materials**
-  **Compressed gases such as MAPP or Acetylene**
-  **Medications and sharps**
-  **Radioactive waste**
-  **Business or commercial waste**
-  **Regular trash or bulk trash**
